Teachers of students with Low Incidence exceptionalities (multiple disabilities) are often challenged to meet the needs of learners with a wide range of skill sets as well as teach the content standards. A different type of planning is required for the teaching of students who take the Alternate Assessment and who are often in multi-grade LRE placements over the course of several years. This training and follow-up networking is designed to build a scope and sequence using the content standards and functional curriculum as a foundation. Thoughtful attention must be paid to what a student learns from Kindergarten through age 21 to ensure that students can leave public education with the knowledge, skills and tools for life after school. There is no charge for this workshop. Advance registration is required (STARS) and participants must attend both days of the workshop. Attendance certificates will be issued at the end of the second day.
