Target Audience: Preschool teachers who have not been trained previously for GGG.

Description:

Get It, Got It, Go! Is one of the assessments that the Office of Early Learning and School Readiness has chosen to collect data on children's progress. Test administration and data reporting takes place twice a year, in the fall and in the spring, and the tool is useful for teachers to monitor children's progress throughout the year. The group that created the DIBELS assessment developed Get It, Got It, Go! Like DIBELS, it measures children's early phonological processing skills.

Teachers can use Get It, Got It, Go! On an ongoing basis to make informed data-based decisions about their instruction and to intervene quickly when a child is not making progress as expected. This three hour training will prepare you to administer and use Get It, Got It, Go! Participants will be able to view an information video about the Ages and Stages Questionnaire: Social Emotional Assessment and then ask follow questions based on Ohio requirements.

Registration:

- Registration is required. Deadline to register is March 2, 2012.
- You must access the STARS V2 via a SAFE account and may obtain a SAFE account by visiting www.ode.state.oh.us and by clicking on SAFE Account Sign-in at the top of the page and follow the prompts. Once you have established a SAFE account and are signed in (account name/password); click on Event Search, review the event by the training date only (i.e. 3/09/2012 and 3/09/2012); click on Event Owner box and type Region 9. Click Search. Highlight the event and click Register for Selected Event button and follow the remaining prompts; until you can print your confirmation page.
